

The Royal Commission Into Abuse In Care Findings - The Presbyterian Church of Aotearoa has now prepared its response to the

findings of the Royal Commission on Abuse in Care

report. They write, "Our response includes our acknowledgement that our Church accepts the findings of the Royal Commission, how we intend to respond, our pathway forward, a lament/waiata, inoi/prayer, and a benediction/te inoi whakamutunga. Our response also includes an apology to those harmed by our actions and inaction. This apology is in addition to the public acknowledgement for historic abuse to survivors, their whanāu and support networks that our Moderator of the General Assembly, Right Rev Rose Luxford, will make in mid-November."

Council invites congregations to share the Church's response.
